Electronic Proof of Insurance

During the 2013 legislative session, changes in Florida statutes now allow the Tax Collector to accept electronic proof of insurance when registering motor vehicles in Florida. The following information is required on all paper and electronic proofs of insurance:

- Florida Automobile Insurance Identification Code
- Name of Insurance Company or Group
- Policy Number and Effective Date
- Type of Coverage
- Named Insured
- Year, Make and VIN Number (if more than 25 vehicles are insured, Fleet Coverage is acceptable)
- Not valid more than one year from effective date
- The following warning of violation of s. 316.646(4), F.S., must be present on all ID cards, "Misrepresentation of insurance is a first degree misdemeanor".

The person providing the device assumes the liability for any damages to the device, should they occur. The electronic format must include the same information required on a paper insurance card and should be the mirror image of the card if both are available.

We hope that these changes will help streamline the registration and renewal processes. If you should have any further questions, please call our Call Center at 352-368-8200.
