CDL Medical Certifications

Due to recent regulatory changes, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations require all Commercial Driver License holders in Florida to certify with the Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles or a Tax Collector's office in one of four categories prior to issuance or renewal of a CDL.

What this means to you?

- ◆ You must certify in one of these four categories:
 - a. **Non-Excepted Interstate**—I operate or expect to operate in interstate commerce and am required to maintain federal medical certification.
 - b. **Excepted Interstate**—I operate or expect to operate in interstate commerce, but engage exclusively in operations that qualify me for exception from the requirement to maintain federal medical certification.
 - c. **Non-Excepted Intrastate**—I operate or expect to operate only in intrastate commerce and am required to meet state of Florida medical certification requirements.
 - d. **Excepted Intrastate**—I operate or expect to operate only in intrastate commerce, but engage exclusively in operations that qualify me for exception from state of Florida medical certification requirements.
- ◆ Provide proof of valid medical certification, if required to carry a medical card.

How do you certify?

You can go to **www.flhsmv.gov** to self-certify or you may come into any of our offices to certify in person.

CDL holders can no longer claim exemption from medical certification requirements because they are not currently operating in non-excepted interstate or intrastate commerce. If not specifically included in category B or D above, they must maintain their medical certification or downgrade to a non-commercial license.

How to Report an Unsafe Driver

Anyone can report a driver who may be unsafe to operate a motor vehicle as a result of a medical condition. **The report is kept strictly confidential under Florida Law.** To get a Medical Reporting Form, call 850-617-3814, e-mail medical@flhsmv.gov or go to www.flhsmv.gov/forms/72190.pdf.

Reporting a medically unsafe driver may be difficult, especially if the driver is a loved one. However, removing unsafe drivers from the road is often necessary for their safety as well as the welfare of others. Your actions may prevent a motor vehicle crash and save lives.

Remember, reporting an unsafe driver is confidential. Your identity is protected under Florida Law.
