Due to recent changes initiated by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, beginning January 1, 2021, vehicles with a model year of 2011 and later are now required to capture the odometer reading on all title transactions for 20 years. With this rule, model year 2011 vehicles will not become exempt from odometer requirements until 2031. All vehicles manufactured with a model year of 2010 or older remain exempt under the 10-year exemption.

With this rule change, there will be some states that are not in compliance and you may see titles with 'EXEMPT' odometers for 2011 vehicles. In this instance, the Department will accept the Out-of-State title and carry the 'EXEMPT' indicator forward on the Florida title.

However, if a 2011 vehicle has a Florida title and the Application for Certificate of Title has been marked as 'EXEMPT' by the purchaser, the transaction documents will be rejected and the purchaser must obtain an odometer disclosure and affidavit to correct the mileage.
